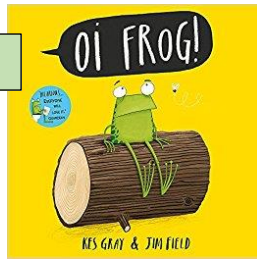
The Royal Wedding

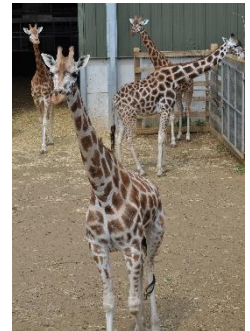
