You may recall I mentioned a Local Authority visit at the beginning of this term, this week I received a letter from Rosemarie Sadler, the Head of Schools. Rosemarie asked me to share her feedback with you.

“As we come towards the end of the academic year I wanted to write to thank you for all your hard work this year. I have been delighted to see the progress the school has made under your leadership.

When I visited last week I noted that the school looks tidy and well organised, pupils were engaged and enjoying their learning in all classes and also in small group work. Teachers’ questioning skills were good and the work in the small number of pupils’ books I looked at was good.

The Early Years Foundation Stage environments have been transformed and pupil outcomes in Early Years are predicted to be good.

I know how hard all your staff have worked to bring about these improvements and I thank them for their great commitment and enthusiasm. The Primary Adviser comments frequently on how well staff take on board advice and use this to make a difference for the children.”


